From all the Staff, we hope you have a very merry Christmas and a happy new year

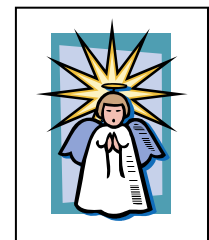
