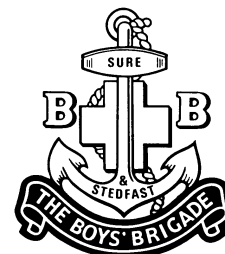

Discipline And The Three Strike Rule

As you are aware, we are a voluntary organisation, and as such the staff give of their time freely. A large amount of time can be spent on preparing work for badge classes, and it is unfair for them if the class is constantly disrupted through poor behaviour. In the past we have taken an easy stance on this, but it has got to a point that it is disrupting the work of the other boys in the class. We are therefore bringing in a three-strike rule.
